A REPORT ON THE VII SVBBI CONVENTION (SVBBI-2023)

Inaugural Session

The VII annual Convention of SVBBI and International Symposium was organized on “Multiomics to One Health: Challenges and Way Forward in Biomedical Research” during 14th - 15th December 2023 at IVRI, along with an alumni meet commemorating the journey of 50 Years of establishment. The Convention was inaugurated by the chief guest Dr. Dheer Singh, Director and Vice Chancellor of the National Dairy Research Institute (NDRI), Karnal and Dr. Triveni Dutt, Director of the Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI). In the event the stalwarts of Biochemistry spread all over the world has been invited to share their experience and expertise. Dr B. P. Mohanty, ARS, Assistant Director General - ICAR chaired and supervised the entire session as president SVBBI. Dr Subhasis Batabyal (Professor, WBUAFS) welcomed all the participants, speakers, organizers as the secretary of the society. Dr Vineet K Singh (Professor, Microbiology, A.T. Still University of Health Sciences) delivered a talk on role of branched chain fatty acids in developing pathogenicity in *Staphylococcus aureus*.
