

## INVITATION

The organizing committee on behalf of Society of Veterinary Biochemists and Biotechnologists of India (SVBBI) invites your active participation in the 9th Annual Convention and National Symposium on "Advancing Animal Health and Production through Biochemical and Biotechnological Innovations" to be organized during 28<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup> November, 2025 by Department of Veterinary Biochemistry, Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, West Bengal University of Animal And Fishery Sciences, Kolkata-700037, West Bengal, India.

### FOCAL THEME

The theme of "Advancing Animal Health and Production through Biochemical and Biotechnological Innovations" emphasizes how advancements in understanding and manipulating biological processes, particularly through biochemistry and biotechnology, can significantly improve the health and productivity of animal populations. This theme highlights the use of biotechnology for disease prevention, improved animal health, enhanced reproductive technologies, and increased productivity of livestock, Aquaculture, wildlife including Poultry and companion animals.

### HOST INSTITUTE AND VENUE

The venue of the symposium will be at West Bengal University of Animal & Fishery Sciences, 37, K.B. Sarani, Kolkata-700037. This University came into existence as a second Veterinary University in the country in the year 1995 at the site of century-old heritage institute of the Veterinary Education and Research, Bengal veterinary College established in the year 1893 and to impart education, training and to conduct research in veterinary and animal sciences, dairy sciences and fishery sciences. The University has been engaged in commendable task of improving the research infrastructure to develop cutting edge technologies for improved management of animal and fishery resources, disease problems, nutrients, water resources and environment. Significant achievement has been made to improve the research activities with the funds made available from State and Central Governments and nongovernment organizations.

Kolkata, the capital of West Bengal, is also known as the 'City of Joy'. The city is rich in history, art, and culture, as well as sports and socio-cultural activities. This was once the capital of British India; therefore there are architectural jewels everywhere. Kolkata is known as

### REGISTRATION AND CALL FOR PAPERS/ABSTRACTS

The organizing committee invites eminent scientists, academicians, policymakers, healthcare professionals, researchers, field veterinarians, nutritionists, industrialists, students, and all other interested individuals concerned with animal health and production to submit their abstracts of research work for Oral and Poster Presentation/E-poster (3'X2') in different technical sessions (200-250 words, MS Word, Times New Roman-12, double space). Soft copies of abstracts of contributory research along with preferred technical session of presentation and NEFT / UPI / IMPS details of registration fees is to be sent through e-mail to the organizing secretary (email id: svbicon2025@gmail.com) on or before by 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2025.

The abstract must contain title, names of authors (Surname, Followed by initials) and address of the institution with email ID & phone number of the presenting authors. The name of the presenting author should be in bold letters and underlined. The acceptance of the abstract shall be communicated through the email to the presenting author.

There shall be exclusive awards in each technical session for students. Students must send a scanned copy of duly signed certificate from the Head of the Department / Institution along with abstract as a supporting document for considering the abstract for the awards as well for concessional registration fee for students.
