A Report on the 8th Annual Convention of Society of Veterinary Biochemists and Biotechnologists of India (SVBBI) and National Symposium (SVBBICON-2024), December 20-21, 2024.

The 8th Annual Convention of the *Society of Veterinary Biochemists and Biotechnologists of India (SVBBI)*, along with the National Symposium on the theme “*Unlocking the Potential of Veterinary Biochemistry and Biotechnology for Food and Nutrition Security*” (SVBBICON-2024), was successfully organized by the Department of Veterinary Biochemistry, College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, DUVASU, Mathura, on December 20–21, 2024.

The convention brought together leading scientists, educators, and students from across the country to deliberate on emerging trends, innovations, and collaborative strategies in veterinary biochemistry and biotechnology. The symposium emphasized the critical role of biochemical sciences in ensuring food and nutritional security, advancing One Health goals, and contributing to sustainable development.



A Compendium-cum-Souvenir, showcasing 30 lead papers and 137 research abstracts, was ceremoniously released by the distinguished guests during the inaugural session. The two-day event witnessed the enthusiastic participation of over a hundred delegates, including SVBBI members, academicians, policymakers, healthcare professionals, researchers, field veterinarians, industry representatives, students, and other key stakeholders from the animal health and production sectors. The convention served as a vibrant platform for sharing cutting-edge research, innovative practices, and collaborative insights aimed at advancing food and nutrition security through the lens of veterinary biochemistry and biotechnology.

SVBBI Awards and Recognitions at SVBBICON-2024

During the inaugural session of SVBBICON-2024, the *Society of Veterinary Biochemists and Biotechnologists of India (SVBBI)* conferred several prestigious Society Awards to distinguished members in recognition of their outstanding contributions to the field.

In a notable new initiative launched this year (2024), the Society began honoring its veteran members aged 65 years and above for their lifelong dedication to veterinary biochemistry and biotechnology. The inaugural SVBBI Veteran's Award was conferred upon Dr. Kranti Dev Singh and Dr. Ajit Kumar Jain, both retired professors from DUVASU, Mathura.

National Symposium and Technical Sessions at SVBBICON-2024

The Annual Convention featured a dedicated National Symposium on the theme “*Unlocking the Potential of Veterinary Biochemistry and Biotechnology for Food and Nutrition Security*”, alongside six focused technical sessions that showcased cutting-edge research and interdisciplinary dialogue.

Their addresses underscored the transformative role of veterinary biochemistry and biotechnology in advancing food and nutritional security across India. The speakers emphasized the need for integrative research, translational applications, and collaborative frameworks to harness the full potential of biochemical sciences in animal health and sustainable development.

Scientific Deliberations and Emerging Insights at SVBBICON-2024

SVBBICON-2024 featured the presentation of over 25 lead papers and more than 100 research papers by faculty members, scientists, and students from various universities and research institutes across India. These contributions, delivered during six technical sessions, spanned a wide array of contemporary advancements in veterinary biochemistry and biotechnology.

Throughout the convention, experts emphasized the urgent need to restructure educational and research frameworks, particularly in the areas of molecular diagnostics, therapeutics, and vaccine development. Discussions also highlighted the critical role of animal-derived food products in enhancing immunity and resilience, especially in the wake of global health challenges such as the COVID-19 pandemic.

Speakers advocated for intensified research in genomics and proteomics, including the development of molecular markers for breed selection and the improvement of animal-based product quality. Innovations such as thermostable next-generation vaccines and cost-effective, field-level diagnostic tools such as LAMP and lateral flow assay were spotlighted as transformative solutions for advancing livestock health, productivity, and food security.

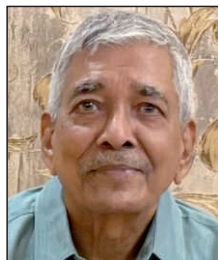

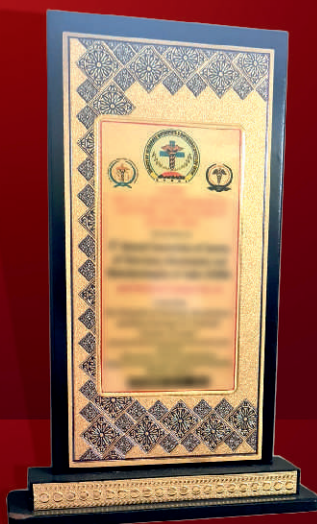
