CALL FOR ABSTRACT

The Organizing Committee of SVBBICON–2026 cordially invites scientists, academicians, researchers, professionals, and students to submit abstracts of their original research papers for oral/poster presentation during the conference. Abstracts should be submitted through email (email ID: svbbi2026@gmail.com) on or before 31st November, 2026.

FORMAT FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstracts should be submitted in MS Word format (.doc/.docx) using Times New Roman font, size 12, with justified alignment and 1.5 line spacing. The abstract should include the title of the research paper followed by the names of all authors, with the presenting author clearly indicated by an asterisk (*). Institutional affiliations of all authors should be mentioned along with the email address and mobile number of the presenting author. Authors should also provide 4–5 relevant keywords in alphabetical order at the end of the abstract and clearly specify the thematic area/session under which the abstract is being submitted. The accepted abstract will be communicated to presenting author through email.

FORMAT FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

Posters should be prepared in a clear and readable format with the title, author(s) name, institutional affiliation, introduction, objectives, methodology, results, conclusion, and references arranged systematically. The poster size should preferably be 4ft × 3ft (Portrait format). The title should be bold and clearly visible from a distance. Text, tables, figures, and photographs should be legible and properly labelled.

WEATHER OF PATNA
